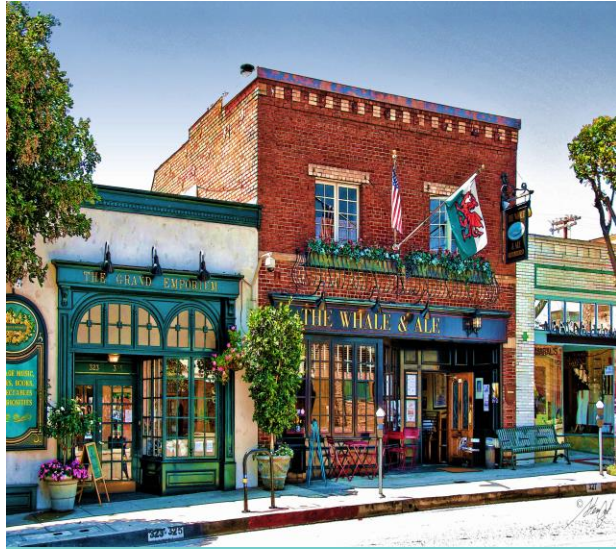

FilmL.A., PBID & the Film Industry

FilmL.A. is a private, 501(c)4 not-for-profit organization established for the public benefit. FilmL.A. coordinates and processes permits for on-location motion picture, television and commercial production under contract to the City of Los Angeles.

PBID

The San Pedro Historic Waterfront Business Improvement District represents the interests of private and public property owners along the LA Waterfront and within downtown San Pedro.

THE FILM INDUSTRY

Los Angeles, once the undisputed home of the film, television and commercial production businesses, is facing increasingly strong competition from other states. This growing competition is fueled in great part by the creation of government financial incentives for production companies to use areas other than Los Angeles.

THE GOAL

The goal of the FilmL.A., PBID & Film Industry partnership is to identify, promote, develop and manage opportunities for film production along the LA Waterfront and within Historic Downtown San Pedro.

The partners agree to provide a “film friendly” experience for residents, merchants, production companies and visitors.

All production shall be permitted as required by the City and County of Los Angeles.

Interruption to traffic, business operation and residents shall be noticed in advance and kept to a minimum.

The use of locations and the fees for location use in the historic downtown and LA Waterfront areas shall be negotiated in advance between the merchants and/or property owner and the production company.

Residents and merchants, whose normal business operation and quality of life are affected by filming shall be entitled to reasonable compensation.

Identify and promote “film friendly” locations along the LA Waterfront and in the Historic Downtown areas.
